Mayor Levine called the meeting to order at 7: 10 p.m.

MINUTES

A motion was made by Trustee Shybunko and seconded by Trustee Gulbransen to approve the Minutes of the April 14, 2009 Board of Trustees Annual Organizational Meeting. The motion was approved 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

TREASURER'S REPORT

A motion was made by Trustee Rosenberg and seconded by Trustee Shybunko to approve the Treasurer's Report and payment of warrants for April 2009. The motion was approved 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

CHIEF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S REPORT

As given by Mayor Levine. Harriet McDonnell addressed the Board.

CORRESPONDENCE

Residents were notified that census takers from the U.S. Department of Census will be going door-to-door during the months of May and June to gather data for the 2010 census.

ENVIRONMENTAL REPORTS

A motion was made by Trustee Rosenberg and seconded by Mayor Levine to approve the Zoning Permit application of **Morrison, 181 Old Field Road**, to remove 4 trees. The motion was approve 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Trustee Gulbransen and seconded by Trustee Shybunko to approve the Zoning Permit application of **Sullivan, 124 Old Field Road**, to remove 4 trees. The motion was approve 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Trustee Gulbransen and seconded by Trustee Shybunko to approve the Building Permit application for **Kaler**, **120 Mount Grey Road**, to remove an existing wood deck and replace it with pavers. The motion was approved 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion subject to review and approval by the Village Building Inspector.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORTS

PARKS AND BUILDINGS AND STREET TREES

Trustee Owen reported that safety pruning of dangerous tree limbs along Old Field Road and Mt. Grey was ¾ complete. A motion was made by Trustee Owen and seconded by Mayor Levine to approve payment of \$1,950 to Usher Tree Experts to finish pruning dangerous tree limbs along the two Village roads. The motion was unanimously approved 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

SAFETY – No Report

STREETS AND ROADSIDES

Trustee Rosenberg reported that several bids had been received and opened on May 6th for repavement of the Village intersections at Old Field Road and Mt. Grey, and Old Field Road and Quaker Path. The cost of the project will be about \$80,000 and will be funded by the Village's County Highway Improvement Program ("CHIPS") account.

FIRE AND SPECIAL PROJECTS

Trustee Shybunko reported that he will be applying for a grant through NYS Green Innovation Grant Program to pay for the new septic system at the Lighthouse. He also addressed an earlier discussion about a proposed cell pole and suggested that the Village

proceed with a feasibility study to determine whether there is a reason to move forward with the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS

Trustee Gulbransen noted that he would be submitting the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ("MS4") Annual Report within the next few weeks. He also spoke of two projects underway to study development in the area: the first is a Three Village Community Trust grant to study preservation and conservation within the footprint of Three Village School District; the second is a Town of Brookhaven 2030 Program to study development and zoning for the next decades. Trustee Gulbransen invited residents to email him or the Village Clerk to obtain those reports that have been issued to date.

REVETMENT RECONSTRUCTION

On April 6, 2009 the Village received and opened 11 bids for the revetment reconstruction project. Mayor Levine reported that the Village is now in a process of due diligence, that the bid is expected to be awarded within the next few weeks, and that work on the revetment should begin during the summer.

NEW BUSINESS

DODGE LANE FOUNDATION

A motion was made by Trustee Rosenberg and seconded by Trustee Gulbransen to direct the Village Attorney to send a Notice of Violation and Notice of Remedy to the property owner at Dodge Lane, Sec 20 Block 1 Lot 4. A Public Hearing will be held at the June 9, 2009 Board of Trustee Meeting to determine whether the open foundation on Dodge Lane constitutes a hazard under the definition of the Old Field Village Code.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW No. 6-2009: Removal of Trees and Substantial Clearing

The Board entered a lengthy discussion on the need to accurately define both "tree" and "substantial clearing" in a manner that would address both residents' landscape schemes and the need of the Village to protect environmentally sensitive properties and deter detrimental runoff patterns. The Mayor asked resident to email him with any suggestions.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW No. 7-2009: Clearing of a Wooded Area

Proposed Local Law will be filed with the Suffolk County Planning Board before it can be scheduled for a Public Hearing and vote by the Board.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW No. 8-2009: Swimming Pool Enclosures

Proposed Local Law #8-2009 will be scheduled for public hearing at the June Board meeting.

Margaret Sobel addressed the Board.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW No. 9-2009: Flood Damage Prevention FEMA

A motion was made by Trustee Shybunko and seconded by Trustee Rosenberg to send the draft Local Law No.9-2009 to the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") for review and to schedule a Public Hearing of Local Law No.9-2009 for Public Hearing at the next board of Trustees meeting on June 9, 2009. The motion was unanimously approved 5-0 with Trustees Gulbransen, Owen, Rosenberg and Shybunko and Mayor Levine voting in favor of the motion.

PUBLIC EXPRESSION
