• The Board discussed the review of the Village Code on Lighting, Chapter 68, 1-6 (LL4-2000).

• The Board discussed snow removal from around fire hydrants. Village Attorney Anthony Guardino said while the obligation to remove the snow from hydrants is with the property owner, the Village may be able to remove it due to health and safety concerns, but suggested finding an alternative method.

• <u>FYI</u>: The TOB has submitted a resolution to the Suffolk County legislature to appoint the TOB Village Clerk as Registrar for Old Field Village, it will be heard at the March 8 meeting.

Old Business

- Revetment updates from Trustee Gulbransen, FEMA funding through **Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) DR-4085**, for erosion control available, the Village was awarded \$264,000. Trustee VanDerBogart commented on Trustee Gulbransen's efforts on the success of the award.
- MCEP Grant (Municipal Consolidation and Efficiency Plan) for the digitalization of Village records through the Town of Brookhaven Electronic Content Management System, storage of Village records at Town facility. <u>The Town does charge an annual fee for record storage</u>. Cell phone coverage within the Village
- Review of DASNY Grant-State & Municipal Facilities Program (SAM) # 12976 for Lighthouse rehab
