Please read into the minutes of the 3-14-23 board meeting. I am traveling and I am unable to attend. I wanted to bring your attention to a situation on Old Field Place regarding neighbors, the street, and flooding. One of the possible factors involved in this issue directly links back to a ZBA decision made May 2, 2016. I was on the board at that time, and I am currently Chairman of the ZBA.

In our deliberations and in our decision the ZBA referenced the site plan with regard to the concern for, possibility of, and control of, flooding. This issue was addressed multiple times by multiple board members during the hearing and it is part of the decision. That site plan was not followed at the time and has still not been fully applied to this property. One example is that the site plan specifies a trench drain across the drive way entrance and an accompanying dry well. There is no drain across the driveway. I bring this to your

attention so you can remedy this situation as it may have a direct result on the issues effecting this street and the flooding that is currently occurring.

Our decision to grant the variance was based, partly, on the site plan. Since the site plan was not followed I wonder if the variance is now null and void?

Addressing this issue is time sensitive. This street association is considering multiple solutions to their flooding and road degradation. I believe that complying with the variance (site plan) is an important part of the solution to these problems.
